The Board would like to share information with you and determine your level of interest in participating in a retreat in August of 2017 for Unity of Fox Valley Congregants at Unity Village. The retreat would coincide with a Total Solar Eclipse that occurs near Unity Village at noon on Monday, August 22, 2017. We would return directly after the eclipse on Monday. Planning this event a year in advance is necessary because space is limited at the Unity Hotel. We will need to reserve a block of rooms within the next couple of months for this event.

Suggested Dates: Friday, Aug. 19-22, 2017

Cost:

- 4-days and 3-night
- Approximately: \$250 (double occupancy) or \$400 (single occupancy).
- The cost will cover 3 hotel nights, all breakfasts, all-day retreat and 2 meals on Saturday. Meals on Fri, lunches and dinners on Fri, Sun and Mon would be expenses that you would pay as you go.
- Also, we plan to car pool to Unity and we will share those travel expenses.

Proposed schedule:

- Saturday: All-day retreat
- Sunday: Explore Village and surroundings
- Monday: Total Solar Eclipse, travel home


