
Men's Ministry

The Green Team will join with the

Unity of Fox Valley Outreach Committee to perform a community service in Batavia. We should dress appropriately. Bring boots, the deeper the better, and long-sleeve clothing. The group will meet at the Blackard Skate Park on Route 25 only a few blocks from the Unity of Fox Valley building. Individuals can help with Fox River clean-up in Aurora, Saturday, April 13, and in Elgin, Saturday, May 18. Going Green includes keeping our rivers clean from clutter and in the case of the Fox River, clean for drinking.


