More than a few other congregants previously signed up as owners of the developing co-op which will be in the

greater Batavia area.

Meanwhile, August is filled with Green Team excitement for two big events following quiet months of May and June.

Your Green Team will sponsor two tables at the **Fair on the Fox** event in Batavia at the

City Council Chambers building on Island Avenue. The event will be from **10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 13**. One table will have information to present to the large annual audience which will peruse the vendor exhibits. Information available will be on Unity of Fox Valley and on the Green Team. We are sponsoring a second table for the Youth and Children's Departments. Crafts annually have been available for children who are with adults and want to be creative.


