"It's déjà vu all over again." (A true classic!)


"Always go to other people's funerals, otherwise they won't come to yours."

Of course, this is funny and brings a smile to your face, but at the same time it is truly profound.





Sunday, August 12th, 11:45-12:15pm 2nd Sunday of the month - Adult Ed Room




News from the Church Office
