Dear Spiritual Family,

Ash Wednesday is just a few days away and that marks the beginning of the Lenten season. Why should we even take time to observe the period of Lent? It seems like an old tradition coming out of old time religion. But we need to give it another look with new eyes - or should I say "New Thought" eyes.

Charles Fillmore, the co-founder of Unity, was ever the metaphysician. He knew that spiritual rituals and traditions serve many purposes. Often we either go into these traditions without giving them much thought or we ignore them completely. Fillmore interpreted long-standing spiritual traditions metaphysically and gave us new insights into their spiritual significance for us on our spiritual journey.

The period of "Lent"was a particular favorite for Charles. Where traditional religions talked about Lent as a time of penance and fasting to prepare ourselves for the celebration of Easter, Charles put a different twist on fasting and denial to prepare ourselves for a celebration of the Resurrection.

Instead of giving up something physical, like smoking or sweets, Charles felt Lent was a perfect time to give up the negative thoughts, self talk, and programming that we carry around and affect our world view and inhibit our spiritual growth. Looking at Lent

metaphysically, Charles asked us to "fast" from all that negativity so that we may also participate in the resurrection as a new spiritual being.

Fast from words that pollute. Fast from complaining. Fast from judging others. Fast from emphasizing differences.

I'm sure you'll come up with your own list. What's essential here is to come up with a list so that these 40 days of Lent will be productive to your "Christ" self and this Easter will be a celebration like none you've had before.


