Men's Group




Tuesday, October 1st & 15th, 7:00pm

1st & 3rd Sundays, 11:45-1:15pm October 6th & 20th, Adult Ed Room



Growth Through Loss & Change




Wednesdays, October 30th to December 11th, 7-9pm Adult Ed Room.


