Virtual Spirituality

I was reflecting on what has and what not has been happening at our church since the middle of March. Obviously, we have not been meeting physically. Oh, how I miss looking you in the eye, the hugs, the camaraderie, the joking around; and let's not forget the food. Since the virus has interrupted our comfortable routine and our savory hospitality, I think I may be a bit undernourished. Obviously, I am joking and well fed. More importantly, I continue to be well fed spiritually.

I am so very grateful for what we have been able to do technologically during the pandemic. Zoom has its issues and drawbacks, and obviously our contact with one another is not what used to be. Still, what meeting virtually has confirmed is that the essence is there. The essence is always there. Perhaps accessing it in a tangible manner has become different, maybe now a little more inconvenient, but what we share has not diminished. In a way, circumstances may have even spotlighted the family aspect of Unity of Fox Valley. I know it has for me. That we miss seeing one another in the flesh and sharing a cup of coffee together only confirms what we share.

The same principle extends to us individually. Virus or no virus, our lives often may fall into the category of virtual. somebody, we can do so with a greater mindfulness of the divine of the person we greet. When we ask somebody, "How are you?", we can do so with a tiny bit more of really wanting to know and a little bit less of doing what we are expected to do. With each tiny little exercise, we start showing up a little less virtual and a little more real.

No doubt our Zoom gatherings are virtual by definition. We transcend the technology not by turning on the computer and logging on, but rather by being truly present to one another regardless of the format. Having to see and speak to one another through our little electronic cannot dampen that. In the same way doing all of the mundane things that life dictates cannot diminish who we are. Spiritually, we are only as virtual as we may choose.

Affirm: Everything I do, say and think is quickened into right action, into productive action, into increased action.


My invisible good already exists.
