Youth Education for the Younger Crowd

As we continue our <u>Sunday morning classes</u> on Zoom through the month of February, the youth and teachers will reflect on the "*Power of Love*". Online Bhagavad Gita Class




1st & 3rd Sundays February 7th & 21st, 1:00 pm, Online


This month we encourage you to affirm your power of Strength, the 2nd of the 12 Powers. And we encourage you to seek out prayer to support you on your spiritual journey.


