Ghosting

It's the bootiful month of October and time to think about witches, skeletons, vampires and ghosts. One of my favorite things about Halloween is that it is a time when we reduce frightening things to ridicule. We cackle at witches. Skeletons tickle our funny bones. We don't let vampires drive us batty. You want to dress up as a ghost? Ghoul for it but if you are driving, be sure to wear your sheet belt.



There is a long-time behavior with a current day term to describe it – ghosting. Ghosting is when somebody just

disappears from a relationship. It is not uncommon in dating. All of a sudden, one of the two people just leaves the relationship without a word, no explanation, no reason, no complaint – nothing! He or she doesn't answer phone calls, text messages, snail mail or any other attempt to make contact. It is not a case of something bad having happened to the person who disappears; they just become "ghosts," leaving the other person or persons confused and hurt.

Seems like a not nice thing to do, doesn't it? Maybe when it happens or more precisely when we do it, we do not even think about it. Well, I am not trying to spook you, but at times I think we all do. Ghosting is not limited to the dating scene. It is something that we do anytime we fail to show up. We do it anytime we deny our presence in response to the Holy Ghost, aka Spirit. Someone reaches out to us and we pretend not to see them – ghosting. A loved one is hurting and we turn on the TV – ghosting. Someone apologizes to us and we respond by snubbing them – ghosting.

It is not hard to do. All you have to do is pretend. All you have to do is remove yourself for any reason from the situations or the persons involved. All you have to do is disappear or choose to close off your awareness. We can be so afraid of being hurt that we choose the pain of separation instead. We can be so afraid of being alone that we choose loneliness as a way to escape it. We even try to do it in our relationship with God.

But what if we made a Halloween pledge to turn it around? What if we gave ghosting a new meaning? Instead of disappearing, what if we deliberately introduced Spirit into every situation, every action and as much as possible into all of our thoughts. If we can laugh at zombies, witches, skeletons, vampires and ghouls; surely we can laugh at our own fears. All we have to do is "ghost" them by keeping Spirit in the picture.

How does a ghost unlock the door to all the answers? With a SPOOK-KEY!
