Did you ever have the strange feeling of gratitude come over you for no apparent reason?


This month we celebrate the holiday of Thanksgiving. While President Roosevelt officially signed it into law in 1941, Thanksgiving had been celebrated in the Americas in different forms both casual and formal for over three hundred years. The oldest historical date goes back to 1621 at Plymouth where the colonists and the Wampanoag Indians came together and celebrated an Autumn Harvest Feast. Go God!

Thanksgiving always has been my favorite holiday for a long time. It took over for Christmas when I was about twelve years old. My family never shared meals together, and I mean never. Breakfast, lunch or dinner – it didn't matter. We never came to the table all together, but more or less "grazed" according to our own schedules. The one and only exception to that was Thanksgiving when my mom and my sisters went all out cooking a traditional sit-down meal that even included a tiny glass of Mogen David wine.

We never did any exercises such as going around taking turns and sharing what we were grateful for. I do not recall anyone even expressing thanks to my mother for preparing the meal. No prayers of thanksgiving were prayed. We laughed and had fun sometimes at one another's expense, but no feelings ever got hurt. I do not recall anybody doing any deep sharing, but for one day or at least one afternoon we were family.

Personally, I cannot recall back then of going to a place of thinking of anything for which I was thankful. We all believed in God, but God always was some distant reality that never was a force in our lives. All I can attest to was an inner feeling of warmth and an unacknowledged knowing that it was good to be alive. What we had or did not have had

nothing to do with anything. God or Spirit never got any credit for it, but I am guessing that God was joyous in seeing grace being put to use.



Over the river and through the wood! These are lyrics from a Thanksgiving song. They represent a journey to grandmother's house (although the original poem said "grandfather") to celebrate Thanksgiving. The song shares a bit of what the journey is like, but the details of the journey are secondary to embarking upon it. All that matters is that blessed trip from our heads to our hearts, a place where God dwells even if we cannot express it as such. On the way there, we are blessed to take in the scenery, the weather, the laughs and the sorrows.

Let us raise our glasses of wine, juice, water or whatever in a toast to Life and say just a simple word of thanks. I'm thinking that if the reality of Spirit ever smiles, we can make it happen just by doing so, and nothing more need be said.

WE ARE REBUILDING THIS VOLUNTEER MINISTRY AND NEED YOUR HELP!!


