When Irish Eyes Weren't Smiling

With March comes the long-awaited spring. March also features March Madness, a really popular college basketball tournament on which millions of dollars are wagered. There is one more very special event in March, a holiday called St. Patrick's Day.

It is very interesting how the celebration of a saint particular to a nationality has become such a phenomenon in our culture. There are others of course like Cinco De Mayo, but celebrations around Cinco De Mayo tend to be more parochial. On St. Patrick's Day people of all backgrounds are wearing green and acting, well, very Irish. The festivities around St. Patty Day seem to take precedence even over Lenten influences.

But it wasn't always this way. More than one hundred and fifty years ago the Irish were despised in America. The refugees seeking haven in America were poor and disease-ridden. They threatened to take jobs away from Americans and strain welfare budgets. They practiced an alien religion and pledged allegiance to a foreign leader. They were bringing with them crime. They were accused of being rapists. (Sound familiar?) And, worst of all, these undesirables were Irish.

It was common for businesses in America to post job openings that include the phrase: "The Irish Need Not Apply." Acts of violence against the Irish were not uncommon. In one instance a Jesuit priest was dragged out into the open and literally tarred and feathered.

Hatred of the Irish was definitely focused. In the 1850's almost the same number of Germans immigrated to the U.S., but were assimilated very easily. Of course, the Germans weren't Catholic, and didn't come tethered to the pope.

Mostly through political paths, the Irish eventually would emerge. Not only would they become assimilated, they became politically prominent. Ironically, some Irish politicians looked and found their own targets of discrimination. Sad but true!

This bit of history is fascinating on many levels. Many people today do not understand that the targets of discrimination may be different but finding people to target is nothing new. As a people we can choose what we wish to take away from history. Watching how the Irish emerged from being hated to being celebrated brings hope to me.

Of course, there still is plenty of hatred, discrimination and racism to go around. There is a lot of work to do. As we raise our glasses to toast on St. Patrick's Day, let us drink (Affirm in Prayer) to all those who remain victims of fear. The real difference will come only when we learn that our differences truly are unique manifestations of the Christ. There is a leprechaun in each of us that can work this magic.


