


April 2022

Ministerial Musings



This month it is difficult to write about anything other than Holy Week and Easter. And I know it will sound strange, but in thinking about different aspects of the Resurrection, I thought of the Gospel of Mark and the phrase, "Render to Caesar."

These were the words of our Way-shower in response to the Pharisees who had asked Jesus if it was fair to pay taxes. Jesus asked them to produce a coin, and then asked whose picture was on the coin. When they answered, "Caesar's," Jesus replied, "Give to Caesar the things that are Caesar's and to God the things that are God's."

The gospel story is a lesson in mindfulness and divine order. It is difficult to sort through this though. At first glance it appears as if Jesus is promoting something separate and apart from an affirmation frequently voiced in Unity, *It's All God*. On the contrary, rendering to Caesar is a call to awareness that we are immersed in God and Spirit is in everything. More than that, it speaks to the bond between our humanity and our spirituality.

One of the calls that Life gives to us is to live. This means doing what is necessary and important to continue the ongoing process of creation by sustaining it. I believe that this is what Charles Fillmore was talking about when he referred to Unity as practical Christianity. We have to do what we have to do. We have to eat; we have to sleep; we have to work; we have to play; we have to do what we have to do for our ourselves and for the world in which we live precisely so we can efficiently express the Christ within.

As much as we might speak or think about our spirituality and our humanity as separate and apart, any separation is impossible. Most of the world right now is appalled, concerned and deeply saddened by the events of the Ukraine. If we could just render to God and not have to attend to Caesar, the Ukraine would be no big deal.

The consciousness of Easter is that God is Life. As such it is irrepressible, and Easter represents the ultimate victory over every form of death. Rendering to Caesar is not a hiccup, a distraction, nor even a nuisance. In a Resurrection consciousness it is a prayer. In Divine Order we give due to Spirit by giving due in Spirit. Is God really in "rendering to Caesar?" Only if you connect the dots.

Prayer Chaplain Ministry

Speaking for myself, peace - in Ukraine, in our beloved USA, and in all our earth - continues to be forefront on my mind and in my heart. And, I imagine, peace is on your heart and mind also. So I thought I would share with you several items that have had a significant impact for me recently.

At the Intergenerational Service held last month on the 20th, Mary Nowroozi shared some excerpts from a *Statement for* Peace she found in a Unity Lesson for Kids, written about twenty years ago:

"Unity stands for peace in the presence of conflict; for love in the presence of hatred; for forgiveness in the presence of injury. Unity honors the many names for God, the many paths to God, the many ways to worship God; for there is only one power and presence of God, and that God loves us equally.

It is therefore the position of Unity to urge all nations, their leaders and their people to turn to God by whatever the name for guidance during challenging times and to pursue peace for this is what honors the God of all our faith traditions. Unity stands for peace."

At our most recent Prayer Chaplain meeting Bobbi shared a prayer from Spiritual Passages, a website (<u>spiritualpassages.org</u>) that offers a Daily Reflection, similar to Unity's Daily Word.

Infinite Presence I pray for my human/soul companions, whatever their citizenship. I affirm that I am one with the people of Ukraine, Russia, and all nations. I am one with those with whom I disagree. No matter their ideology, political party, religion, race, or lifestyle, we are connected in Spirit, and I pray for their well-being. Thank you, God, forever. Amen.

Our beloved Peace Song, which we sing each Sunday at the end of our service, has become more pertinent during these times. This song was written in 1955 by Jill Jackson-Miller and Sy Miller. Per Wikipedia, "It typically concludes Unity Church services each week." And on TruthUnity.net (a wonderful resource for classic and current articles written by Unity and New Thought authors and teachers), Mark Hicks states that "Many or most Metaphysical Christian churches conclude their service by singing 'Let there be peace on earth and let it begin with me.'"

Together, as we set our intentions on peace, pray and sing for peace, let's remember the second part of the first line in the Peace Song, "let it begin with me!"


"Peace is ours to remember, to imagine, and to create."
