Cinco de Mayo: A Hidden Message?

A holiday that seems to be growing in popularity is <u>Cinco de Mayo</u>. It never was much of a celebrated holiday, at least not in the U.S., until the 1980's when liquor companies decided it was a good focal point to sell alcoholic beverages. Never underestimate capitalism and the power of advertising. Cinco de Mayo triggers more sales of beer in some years than the Superbowl or St. Patrick's Day.

Many people mistakenly think that Cinco de Mayo is a celebration of Mexico's independence. It is not. It simply is the celebration of a Mexican military victory over France in the city of Puebla on May 5, 1862. It was a significant event for a couple of reasons, and looking back it may have had some intangible bearing on history for the U.S.

Up until that battle, the French had not suffered a military defeat for nearly fifty years. Adding to the intrigue the French military that day consisted of over 8,000 well-equipped soldiers fighting against about 4,000 not so well-equipped Mexican forces. Despite the odds, the Mexican soldiers won the battle. The Mexican victory united the Mexican people and dramatically lifted the spirits and the morale of the Mexican people. Historian <u>Justo Sierra</u> has suggested in his *Political Evolution of the Mexican People* that, had Mexico not defeated the French in Puebla on May 5, 1862, France would have gone to the aid of the <u>Confederate States of America</u> in the <u>American Civil War</u> and the United States' destiny could have been different. Maybe, maybe not.

Mexico's victory over the French was short lived. The French army returned a year later with 30,000 troops. They defeated the Mexican army and captured Mexico City. They installed Emperor Maximilian as the ruler of Mexico. This too ended up being short-lived as after the civil war with aid from the U.S., the French were defeated and driven out.

There is a practical and spiritual point to all of this. It is so easy for us to caught up in the whirlwind of all of our problems. The truth is that we can only fight the battle or the demon that is immediately before us on any given day at any given moment. The big picture can be so overwhelming particularly when it includes those painful experiences and guilt from days long past. But on any given day despite the odds, we can stand firm in the face of any given matter or person by affirming who we are and doing the loving thing in that moment. Regardless of the immediate or long-term consequences, this will spell victory.

Well, what about the fact that a year later the French defeated Mexico? Or, what about the fact that a year later, I may have lost a loved one or given in to an addiction or lost my job? It doesn't matter! Every day you still can choose to do battle, again by trying to do the loving thing. And those earlier victories will persist in your heart and in your being because they mirror who you are.

We should celebrate Cinco de Mayo. If we have a beer or a taco, let's not do so because it has become the thing to do. Let's do so in prayerful celebration of what happened in Puebla, Mexico in 1862 and the eventual freedom that resulted. You never know. That Spirit may carry all the way to Ukraine or even make a practical difference in our own lives.


