#### **Ministerial Musings**



Here we are. August is upon us. Every year at least once every week in August I listen to Neil Diamond's *Brother Love's Traveling Salvation Show*. It was not his first hit and only reached number 22 on the song charts. The opening lyrics are, "Hot August Night." The first time I heard it I knew I would be a Neil Diamond fan forever.

The song is about a traveling evangelical preacher. My affinity for the song was unrelated to any ministerial call I may ever have had. It was the emotion and passion that I heard in Neil's voice and lyrics. What inspired this young Jewish man, a New Yorker no less, write and sing about a preacher? And was he acting in his passionate delivery or was he feeling it?

It did not matter. I did not care. I was feeling it every time I played the song. The call that I heard had nothing to do with any official ministerial aspirations; at that time, I had none. The call that I heard was all about being a little less full of myself, and a little more about mindful of, I don't know, everything.

There is a reference in the song to the tent being engulfed in silence waiting to hear the message. This is captured in the lyrics: "And when you almost bet you could hear yourself sweat...". It is a strong testimony of a hunger not just to hear the word, but an open expectation of the presence of some something somewhere and somehow that will make

a difference in our lives. To me it is very much in tune (no pun intended) to where I am when I go into the silence. It is easiest to find something in the midst of nothing.

The inclusivity of the message is reflected in the words, "Pack up the babies and grab the old ladies cuz everyone goes." And the message is simple. You got two good hands. Use one to reach out to one who is in trouble. Use the other when your heart is troubled to reach out to the "Man up there cuz that's what he's there for." Notwithstanding the references to "man" and "he" and "up there," it is a simplification that tells us our spiritual journey need not be all that complicated. If we can just let go of the drama and maintain our focus on the presence of Spirit and one another, we can get on a spiritual roll.

We all have different problems, worries and issues. Yet, we all share that we have problems, worries and issues. Some are more serious than others. The nature of all of them is that they can wear us down, make us grow tired and overwhelmed. Brother Loves message is simple. Maybe that is the true message – Keep it simple: Love God and one another. Was this a song ever? Who knows? But it should be music to our ears.



### **Prayer Chaplain Ministry**



Welcome to August, the last month of summer, meteorological speaking. It never ceases to amaze me how quickly the months fly by! This month is noteworthy as it's our 1st anniversary of "in person" services and events after a year and a half of meeting virtually! Yet all in our world hasn't returned to what we remember as "normal" in the days before Covid and even before that. And it's looking as if things will continue to shift in the foreseeable future.

As Unity students we know that we are unlimited spiritual beings, that we have within us resources that will guide and support us as we navigate in this evolving world! I would like to share a few excerpts from the two books that Rev. Mike used in the recent Welcome to Unity Class. (Both books are available on Amazon.)

The first is from Eric Butterworth's *Unity: A Quest for Truth.* "On the human level of appearances, it seems that changes can lead to loss and injustice. But beyond the appearance is a level of experience where God's law of adjustment is always active, turning losses into gain, revealing the truth that even if (it) was intended for evil, God intends it for good... Divine order is always established within and beyond the experience for good." (p. 102)

How can we look beyond the appearances that seem to surround us in this life? If you have read or studied any Unity writings, you might be familiar with this answer - practice prayer and meditation. The book *Alternatives, New Approaches to Traditional Christian Beliefs* by William L. Fisher describes a number of traditional types of prayer, then offers more effective ways to pray. "Real prayer is an entrance into spiritual communion with God. This can only be done when we pray our own heartfelt prayers, when we pray in order to feel a sense of kinship with God... The Apostle Paul instructed us to 'pray constantly.'" He goes on to say that we don't have to be on our knees or point our folded hands upwards. The position of our body is not important, "but the position of our mind is all-important. We can have a constant *attitude* of prayer." (p. 32)

This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

If, in this evolving world, you have ever contemplated becoming a prayer chaplain, we will be offering our Prayer Chaplain Ministry Training in October 10/14 & 15, and November 11/18 & 19 - one Friday evening and Saturday each month. I know I say this almost every month, but it always bears repeating, our Spiritual family is


blessed with soooooo many talented, gifted, and generous folks and we don't take this for granted!!! We bless and appreciate each and every one of you!!!
