What Does He Know?

Maybe it is because we are bored and tired of winter. Maybe it is because we are prone to seeking amusement in strange places. Maybe it is because we inherently are gullible. Whatever it may be, we all seem to be at the very least casually intrigued by the annual tradition of Groundhog Day.

Groundhog Day has a long-standing history. Its origin goes back to Germany centuries ago. The Germans did not use a groundhog. In fact, there was a succession starting with using bears awakening from hibernation. As bears became more and more scarce, the Germans began to use foxes, but eventually settled on using badgers. German immigrants brought the tradition with them to Pennsylvania.

In Pennsylvania the tradition would shift to groundhogs going back to the 1840's. Although Groundhog Day is celebrated in different parts of our country and Canada, the most renowned groundhog is Punxsutawney Phil. Punxsutawney Phil, or PP got his first name from the town; speculation has it the "Phil" was adopted as a tribute to a person of royalty.

Every February 2nd, PP is imposed upon to emerge and predict the weather. The folklore is that if PP sees his shadow, there will be six more weeks of winter. If he does not see his shadow an early spring is forecast. Despite the fact that PP's track record has not been all that accurate, Groundhog Day is a major happening in Punxsutawney. On many occasions 40,000 people have shown up to celebrate PP's day in the sun, or not. It is strangely similar to many current day political rallies both in number of attendees and the lack of reliability on the part of the star attractions.

Perhaps it is all in good fun, a perfectly wonderful reason for getting into it all. Perhaps Groundhog Day by analogy offers a spiritual lesson. The underlying thrust in our spiritual paths is not about getting it right as much as missing the

mark is an acceptable part of the process. In this knowing we affirm that Truth is within our grasp notwithstanding the hiccups in getting there.

The lesson that PP offers us is that nailing the correct forecast is secondary to continuing to search and try. A very real corollary to that is that the worst mistake we can make would be to remain in a hole and not venture forth. Thank you PP! You are a true gift beyond a shadow of a doubt.

Prayer Chaplain Ministry



Thank heaven it's February, the shortest month of the year and the month we begin to experience more light in our days! Lent begins later this month - <u>Ash Wednesday</u> falls on the 22nd. And, of course, February is the month we focus on **L-O-V-E**. Valentine's Day paraphernalia pops up in stores along with the "after Christmas" sales.

Love is a topic that's been written about more than any other; more than peace, war, history, politics; even more than culture or, believe it or not, religion! In my 1996 Oxford Dictionary and Thesaurus there are 8 definitions of love as a noun and 4 as a verb. Rather than defining it, the most popular passage about love in the Bible, written by St. Paul (1 Corinthians 13:4-8), tells us more about what love is and does, and isn't and doesn't.

Referencing more metaphysical material (since this is a Unity newsletter), Charles Fillmore, in *The Revealing Word*, calls love "The pure essence of Being that binds together the whole human family." He goes on to say, "Love is an inner quality that sees good everywhere and in everybody." Emmet Fox, a spiritual teacher and leader in the New Thought movement, declares, in *Around the Year with Emmet Fox*, that Love is the "third main aspect of God. God is not loving but Love itself..."

As I was perusing quotes, poems and essays for this missive I came across a book we had been using in the Gita class facilitated a year or so ago by Carl and Lucy Klemaier. Love Letters from Spirit by Laura Dickenson is a channeled book, highly acclaimed by Jack Canfield of the Chicken Soup series. The chapter, Day 2, "Trusting and Loving Yourself," spoke to me because it's about self-love, an aspect of love that is often overlooked, yet is so essential as we progress on our spiritual path. These are the last two paragraphs...

Honor yourself. Learn to treasure your unique beauty, creativity and wisdom. These qualities are part of you, ready to bloom gloriously if not repressed or pressured into another direction. Value what you have to offer; develop it with perseverance and integrity. Trust yourself. The fact that you enjoy something, finding it fascinating or challenging, is a clue that it might be right for you. Life is meant to be interesting and fulfilling and you are meant to participate.


Love each day for the insight and progress it brings. Love your process of personal expansion and sharing your gifts. Love yourself.
