

Et Tu?

There is a very old Roman holiday that has long been abandoned in modern times. It is the Ides of March. During those early days of the Roman Empire long before its marriage to the Church, the Ides was a very religious holiday. The Ides were regarded as sacred to Jupiter, the Roman supreme deity. However, other gods also were remembered and offered sacrifices both officially and privately. All in all, in was a holiday celebrated with festivals that featured partying, drinking and revelry. There was a thread of moral fiber to the holiday as many regarded it as the time to settle all past due debts.



Julius Caesar's death triggered a major bloody civil war in the empire that would last for years. Many viewed Caesar's assassination as a sacrilege; others referred to it as a religious sacrifice. It is fascinating how both sides spun the event around religion arguing it was either a travesty against Jupiter or in accordance with their God. And we think our current polarization in Washington is extreme and out of control! Four years after Caesar's death Octavian executed 300 senators to avenge the assassination.

Going back to the words, "Et Tu Brutus?", which Shakespeare attributed to Caesar, these words have meaning for us today. The words are Latin and translate to, "And you too?", or, "Even you?" Some of the hardest times we experience are the hurts we suffer at the hands of those we love and are

supposed to love us. Some of those moments trigger an inner struggle or civil war.

A common human error is to point our fingers outward and not so much at the Brutus within. Maybe it is because we struggle with owning how we shoot ourselves in the foot or worse. Looking at his friend, Brutus, as the obvious guilty culprit did not save Caesar's life. However, looking inward during the Ides of March in the spirit of settling debts; that is, what we owe to ourselves might be an exercise in growth. Et tu anger? Et tu grudges? Et tu my thoughts? Et tu my ego? And yes, "Et tu my heart?"

2023 seems to be *March*ing along rather rapidly...

Although this winter has been relatively mild as winters go, I, for one, am ready for spring - longer daylight hours, warming temperatures, fresh green leaves budding on the trees, and flowers, flowers, flowers! But before renewal comes release: before resurrection comes crucifixion - crossing out what no longer serves us in our lives. By the

time this newsletter is released, we will be a week into Lent; the perfect time to deepen our practice, begun in January's Burning Bowl and White Stone rituals, of letting go what no longer serves us on our spiritual journey and opening our hearts to all the good that life holds for each one of us.

The Unity Lenten Booklet that has been made available to us - 40 Days of Letting Go - is a wonderful gift that we can use to guide us during this Lenten season. Each Sunday presents "the process of letting go through means such as detachment, nonresistance, denying the power, surrender." The daily topics focus on specific habits or actions, listed alphabetically, and include "an affirmation to help shift your consciousness."

Beginning mid March two of our Licensed Unity Teachers are facilitating a class featuring Eric Butterworth's *Discover the Power Within You*. In this Unity classic Rev. Butterworth shares and explores the greatest discovery of all time: the ability to see the divine within us all. Maria Cosentino is teaching this 6-week class on Sundays, beginning March 12th, at noon in the Adult Ed Room. Deb McQuaid is offering her class on Wednesday evenings, starting March 15th, ONLINE, at 6:30 PM.

Both of these are wonderful tools we can use in this Lenten season to enhance and deepen our spiritual practice which, of course, is anchored by prayer and meditation.


