Youth Education for a Younger Crowd

Our New Year will kick off with our much-anticipated, traditional <u>Burning Bowl</u> <u>Ceremony</u> involving the youth and their teachers and parents. This ritual will commence downstairs with a meditation, during which we will reflect on both intangible and tangible aspects of our lives. This includes contemplating concerns and fears as well as acknowledging habits like overindulging in "junk food" or playing too many "computer games" that truly don't contribute to our overall health and well-being.

Following the meditation, we will write down these aspects on flash paper, representing our decision to let them go. We will then walk upstairs to join the congregation to release our papers quietly and safely into the Burning Bowl. Afterward, we will return downstairs for our **White Stone Ceremony**. This segment will commence with another reflective meditation, after which everyone will inscribe on small white stones one or more new concepts that we anticipate will positively manifest in the new year 2024 and beyond. This ceremony is truly an uplifting way to embark on the New Year!

Throughout the rest of January, the youth will delve into the exploration of the **Power of Faith**. **Dark Blue** is the designated color for this power, and **Peter is the disciple** associated with it. To deepen our comprehension of this power within the context of our spiritual beliefs, we will delve into the miracles of Jesus, including his instances of healings from the following Bible passages: Healing of the Centurion's Servant (Matthew 8:5-13; Luke 7:1-10) and Healing of the Ten Lepers (Luke 17:11-19). Regarding the healing power of Peter, we will explore Acts 5:15 which narrates, "As a result, people brought the sick into the streets and laid them on beds and mats so that at least Peter's shadow might fall on some of them as he passed by." We will explore the

metaphysical significance of this passage and its implications of our own understanding in spiritual healing.

Furthermore, with respect to healing, our teens and Dawn, our Teen Youth Director, will be involved in a community service project of "healing of the hunger." On Wednesday, January 3rd, from 4:30 to 6:15 pm, they will be packing nutritious meals at **Feed My Starving Children** in the Aurora location for hungry children around the world. 

Here at Unity of Fox Valley we honor the tradition of reflecting on yesterday and welcoming the future with two rituals, our **Burning Bowl/White Stone Ceremony**. During the Burning Bowl we are

encouraged to "release that which no longer serves" us and in the White Stone Ceremony we open to Spirit to reveal a new *name* for us to "joyfully claim new possibilities for who we want to be and what we want to express in the New Year."


