

Well, 2024 is moving right along! Coming from a "no snow" Christmas we were plummeted into an arctic January with a couple of snow events in the first 3 weeks of the month. Whatever will February bring?



Well, for one, this February brings us an extra day - this is a leap year! Per the Encyclopedia Britannica, which refers to this occurrence as *Leap Day*, the Egyptian king,

Ptolemy Euergetes' attempt to add a leap day to the 365 days Egyptian calendar in 238 BCE was refined over the following centuries. In 1582 the Gregorian calendar reformed the concept by eliminating leap years in century years that couldn't be divided by 400, the year 1900 being the last "non" leap year. 2100 will be the next - an occurrence I'm not likely to experience!

Valentine's Day is a highly celebrated February holiday and, in our Christian culture, the observance of Lent also. This year <u>Ash Wednesday</u> and Valentine's Day fall on the same day! Black History Month occurs in February, too. This year's theme is *African Americans and the Arts*. Adding to the list of notable events, February hosts Ground Hog Day and the Super Bowl! And best of all, in my opinion, February is the last meteorological month of winter, even though it has the reputation of being the snowiest month of the year in our Northern Hemisphere.

Without any further ado and not being able to think of a clever segue, I, along with Bobbie and Wanda Faye, invite you to consider learning, first hand, more about the <u>Prayer Chaplain Ministry</u> that has been a part of Unity of Fox Valley these past 22 years. 
