Puff and Lugh

This is one of the strangest titles I ever have come up with not just for our newsletter but for anything I ever have authored. What are these and how are they even closely related? Even after I disclose who or what they are, the connection may not be obvious. However, figuring it out and putting the pieces together might be fun.

Starting with Puff, he was a mighty dragon and a companion and playmate of Little Jackie Paper. Puff and Little Jackie were the main characters in the Peter, Paul and Mary song, *Puff the Magic Dragon*. The song is the story of their wonderful relationship and its sad ending. Although it is short and musical, it is folklore in a true sense.





The folklore surrounding Lugh goes back to medieval times. According to some scholars, the word leprechaun comes from the ancient Irish-Celtic god and cultural hero Lugh. Lugh was originally the god of the sun and light, and then he became a great warrior ruler of ancient Ireland. Lugh was a "small person" and the king of a legion of small people that once ruled Ireland before it was Ireland.

According to Encyclopedia Britannica, Lugh's stature (literally) diminished over time as the Christianization of Europe gathered pace. He eventually was transformed into *Lughchromain*, meaning "stooping Lugh." Lugh thus became a sort of fairy craftsman, and from there, Lugh became 'leprechaun', the diminutive fairy-goblin in medieval folklore. Both Puff and Lugh share two other fates. Eventually, as their days of glory ended, they both lived out their remaining days in caves. Much more significantly, their days of glory

came to an end in a way that paralleled a loss of innocence by those who once had helm them in reverence.

Whenever there is change, there are consequences. Something that had been is destined to become what once was. Change for the better or change for the worse, it makes no difference. There always are goodbyes attached, oftentimes along with tears, be they shed in joy or sorrow. Certainly, all of this must play a significant part in our resistance to change and putting on newness. Whether forced upon us or proactively determined by us, change requires both faith and courage along with a wisdom as to what we carry with us and what we abandon as we move on.

In the song, the ending implies a sad fate for Puff, but maybe not. It is possible another Little Jackie Somebody might have come along and resurrected the experience of love for Puff. Inasmuch as it is a mythical fable, we are free to write and add a new verse to Puff the Magic Dragon. All it would take would be a revisit to our innocence and the rediscovery of the Little Jackie in us.

As for Lugh, he in fact has been resurrected and in a very positive way. Cleverly, early Irish immigrants launched a campaign in response to the xenophobia that was heaped upon them. They went out of their way to include and invite non-Irish folks to their parades and celebrations, and they introduced the fun myths of leprechauns to America. How can you hate a little tiny creature who hides a pot of gold at the end of a rainbow or the folks that shared such gaiety with the world?

Almost forgot, leprechauns always dress in green, and Puff, well, he was green. St. Patty's Day is our opportunity to join in the fun by wearing green ourselves. We can do it just for the fun of it. We also can do it with a small mindfulness of the positive things that green represents. You know, things like spring and new growth, prosperity and brussels sprouts. Yes, brussels sprouts.



And maybe we can tip a green hat or take a sip, just a wee bit of green beer if so inclined, toasting Lugh and Puff. I am certain the amazing things Little Jackie Paper went on to do were done with the love of Puff beneath his wings, and ditto for Lugh and the Renaissance.

This class is meant for anyone interested in prayer and praying with others or yourself.



For the time being, however, we can enjoy the spring like weather as we move into actual springtime; appreciating each day's increasing minutes of sunlight, early flowers poking their delicate blooms through the warming earth, and buds beginning to bloom on the bare branches of trees all around us.


However you spend this Lenten month of reflection, I pray that this Easter you will feel renewed as you open to the Divinity within you!
