Ministerial Musings

There is a plethora of topics to write about in May. There is Cinco de Mayo which does not translate out to five kinds of mayonnaise. There is Mother's Day, always a proper focus. There is the very appropriate Memorial Day, which we will focus on the last Sunday of the month. We also have May Day, which is kind of like Labor Day Lite. Finally, there is a myriad of zany holidays celebrated throughout the month.



After much thought I decided to go with the Kentucky Derby which edged out all other considerations in a photo image in my mind. Horse racing is known as the Sport of Kings, and traditionally it has a true royal aura about it. It has a long and honored history; this year will be the 148th year of the Derby. It is the longest continually held sporting event in America, and one of the most prestigious horse races in the world. One of the event's nicknames is, "The Greatest Two Minutes in Sports."

There are other interesting factoids that have become party of the Kentucky Derby tradition. It has its own cocktail, the mint julep. Spectators at the event dress up in ostentatious hats that make Easter bonnets pale in comparison. Traditional foods served at Churchill Downs include Chocolate Pecan Pie. But truly the ROSE is the quintessential part of the Kentucky Derby.

The true nickname for the Kentucky Derby is, "The Run for the Roses." The phrase now is borrowed by many hard-fought competitions or demanding challenges of any kind, but truly it belongs to the Derby. Going all the way back to 1883, a lush blanket of 554 red roses is awarded to the Kentucky Derby winner each year. The garland of roses weighs approximately 40 pounds; it almost seems like the poor horse who already is exhausted is being punished for winning.

The rose always has been a sign of royalty, and traditionally a symbol of love and romance. Roses also are a metaphor for beauty, sensuality, secrecy, and mysticism. (Rose also sings and plays a mean guitar, but I digress.)

Until I researched for this article, I never knew about the connection between the rose and mysticism, yet it really makes a lot of sense. Everything else associated with the rose has a divine aspect to it. As we reach out in order to bring out that which is within us, we strive for a higher greater dimension of truth, beauty, love. We strive to achieve a sensuality to our Christ essence. Or, in other words, we make a "Run" at making the Spirit that dwells within us visible in every way.

As long as we refrain from making our lives a spectator sport, odds are that we will be favored. Time to wake up and smell the roses!

Youth Education for a Younger Crowd

At this time every year, the youth observe May Day on the first Sunday by celebrating with a lively song and dance around our Twelve Powers May Pole. This pole, adorned with twelve vibrant ribbons, each representing one of the 12 Powers, holds significant symbolism with respect to the 12 Disciples and the 12 months of the year. Weather permitting, we intend to uphold this age-old tradition outdoors, on our church lawn, honoring the delightful arrival of the spring month of May in a truly joyful way!

The Power for this month is **POWER!** It is symbolized by the color **Purple** and represented by the disciple *Phillip*. The youth will learn that Phillip was among the first to join the followers of Jesus and he urged Bartholomew to join them too. After Pentecost, Phillip and Bartholomew traveled together, using their spiritual power, healing the sick and spreading the spiritual message of love. The nature symbol for POWER is Air/Wind and the location in the body is the Throat/Root of the Tongue.

In honor of Mother's Day, we will encourage the youth to recognize the significance of showing appreciation to the remarkable mothers in their lives through prayer, Bible stories about mothers, and through creating Mother's Day Cards each personalized with their own creative touch. 

Prayer Chaplain Ministry

As I'm writing this missive tonight the temperature outside is still 70 degrees - it reached the lower 80's today. And it's only mid-April. The highs forecasted for the end of the week are in the lower 50's. Spring in the Midwest... The temperatures all throughout this past winter and early spring just seemed to go up and down, up and down, reminding me of the 'seesaw' I used to play on when I was small. By the time this newsletter comes out May will have arrived and who knows what the temps will be.



Today (3 1/2 weeks ago if you are reading this on May 1) we had our traditional Prayer Chaplain Dedication. We welcomed a new chaplain, Pam Verner Skaar; welcomed Denise Hage back as an active chaplain; and we three 'veterans' - Wanda Faye Holmes, Bobbi Severson and Marie Manella - committed to continue serving in the 23rd year of this sacred ministry here at Unity of Fox Valley.

Unity was founded on prayer and practices what we call affirmative prayer, which is completely different from the prayers many of us learned when we were young. "The teaching of oneness-meaning there is only one divine power and therefore God and humanity are one in absolute Truth-changes prayer. Rather than presuming the power we seek is outside and separate from us, affirmative prayer empowers us to respond to life's circumstances by drawing upon the Truth of oneness. We can recognize, claim, and embody the fullness of our divinity in the midst of our human experience." This is from Chapter One in the book, *Discover Your Divinity* by Linda Martella-Whitsett and Deeann Weir Morency - which was used in the prayer class taught in March and April.

If you sometimes feel like the 'seesaw' weather we've been experiencing lately, I invite you to plant the seeds of Truth in your consciousness. Since May feels like a 'beginning season' to me I thought I'd share a poem written by Frank B. Whitney, who founded *Daily Word* in 1924 and served as its first editor for 14 years.

Beginning Again

It matters not what may befall,
Beyond all else I hear the call
"You can begin again."
My courage rises when I hear
God's voice allay the thought of fear
And when [God] whispers gently, near,
"You can begin again."

When once quite all the world seemed wrong,

"You can begin again."


Begin again? Another chance!
