Every once in a while, Susan will wave a spoonful in front of me and say, "Taste this." I do and generally before I can comment, she will say, "I think it needs a little something." Alternatively, sometimes the critique is in the form of, "It's too salty," or "It's too spicy."

Recipes and concoctions always are a blend of different seasonings. Many of us have grown up watching moms and grandmothers adding a pinch of this and a pinch of that in order to arrive at just the right taste. The most famous chefs in the world often follow this same technique. It is a science that is perfected by a form of art.

Conflicting thoughts even within the same brain are not all that unusual. That is why sorting them may seem like a monumental task.

On a broader stage things become even more complicated. The United States of America rarely is united. We have become polarized to such an extent that, "One nation under God **indivisible**" has become virtually a gross misinterpretation of the American recipe. Sorting through things on a national level indeed will be monumental.

It is not that there ever has been a clearly defined consciousness of Americanism. It always has been an eclectic blend of flavors: liberals, conservatives, moderates, natives, immigrants, etc. The concept of America being a melting pot always had a certain appeal. Diversity was a valued ingredient. Whatever we have been historically probably could not be categorized properly, but that was our charm and our magic.

Nothing worldly is forever. Humanity always must evolve and even those old respected values and recipes are subject to change. This is true of both our personal perspectives and our collective awareness. Whether you are unhappy with things either on a personal level or how our democracy has evolved recently, it may be worthwhile celebrating your independence by adding a little something. The emphasis for this session will be the Workbook from A Course in Miracles.


The Course invites us to retrain our minds so that we can experience more peace in this world.

Prayer Chaplain Ministry

The following quotes are excerpts from a sermon Eric Butterworth gave on Sunday, July 1st, 1979, entitled **The Greatest Freedom**, which can be found in its entirety on TruthUnity.net. Although this talk is 45 years old, the words he spoke seem fitting for our times.



"On this coming July 4th, known as Independence Day, there will be a lot of talk about freedom. And against the backdrop of (inserting what we are facing in 2024)... there may well be a desire to redefine the word freedom."

"In America we have not only entertained the idea of freedom as *doing* what we want but also of *having* what we want... All we can think of is if we have enough money to *buy* there should always be the freedom to *have*."

"Jesus said 'you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free.' We miss the real meaning if we think of freedom as... from shortages, freedom from pain etc. For there are no shortages, no limitations in God or in Truth. These things are in human experience. Truth makes you free in mind ... free to choose the level of consciousness in which you meet life and change in circumstances."

"So on this Independence Day, let us reflect upon this new insight into freedom - not the attempt to get freedom... from people, from problems, from pain, from insecurity. Let us begin to think of freedom in a more creative sense: the *freedom to be*, to become something, to be big enough to deal with the experiences of life... freedom to release our spiritual capacities."

"When we understand this, we will begin...each day anew in our quest for understanding. For the greatest freedom is the choice to begin again."

As we commemorate and celebrate freedom this month, let's use the tools of our spiritual consciousness to change our world. Let's *walk our Unity talk* together as we hold the high watch and create a sacred space for **all** to experience *freedom to be*, for **all** to express *Oneness*, for **all** to be *celebrated* - for there to be a place for **all** in the world.

Together let's pray this hymn written by William Bradbury many years ago:


"From hand to hand the greeting flows; From eye to eye the signals run; From heart to heart the bright faith glows; The seekers of the Light are one."
