I write this newsletter at a time when the political winds are howling. The former president of our country has been targeted in an assassination attempt. The Republican Party last week held its convention and nominated candidates for president and vice president. A few days ago President Joe Biden yielded to pressure from his own party and withdrew his candidacy for our highest office. He likely will be replaced on the ticket by Vice president Kamala Harris, and she apparently will be formally nominated at the Democratic convention later this month.

These events represent the highlights. While they manifest outcomes, they are secondary to the underlying chaos which sired them. It always has been held as a good idea not to talk politics in public as people tend to get emotional when it comes to promoting their candidates and attacking the opposition. However, never before have I seen the environment as volatile as it has been since Donald Trump was elected in 2016 and growing even more so up to the present day. Families have become split, and lifelong friends have gone separate ways.

I think there is a common thread that runs through it all – FEAR! I believe we are in a significant era politically as a nation. I call it Scaredy-cat politics. In debates and arguments all over the country issues are mentioned and referenced, but the underlying

theme seems to be fear. In ads, public speeches, email solicitations, and even text messages; there is virtually no talk about positions or issues except to instill fear if the other guy gets in. All of this contributes to an atmosphere of uncertainty, the perfect breeding place for fear.

The problem with fear is that it brings paralysis. In fear we disappear. The chaos has been so overwhelming politically that many are driven to withdrawing from it, or at least trying to escape from it. When we do this, the fear does not go away. It lingers. More than that, it fosters a feeling of helplessness. Why bother? Why vote? What I do won't matter anyway.

It really does matter though. Winston Churchill gave the famous quote: "We have nothing to fear but fear itself." He was not aware of it, but this was a very "Unity" thing to say. Regardless of how high the level of the chaos may get; it only becomes a real threat if we respond with complacency or withdrawal. If we feel that democracy in America has become or is becoming tarnished, we should not be afraid to polish it and restore it. We cannot do this while refraining because of fear, and nobody has the power that each of us holds.

Collectively, being involved really makes a difference. A bucket of water contains hundreds of thousands of drops, but each drop ads to the water level. Every drop of consciousness adds to the collective level of awareness. Our level of democracy is directly proportionate to that level. What we think and the actions we take actually matter and make a difference. If you feel like a "drop in the bucket," celebrate it. Do not be discouraged.

My daughter has two cats. Whenever I visit one of them hides; the other one meows. I don't speak feline, but my sense is that the one that meows is saying, "I'm here, lets engage." There may be a language barrier, but we seem to communicate and get it done. Scaredy-cats miss out.

It is a chaotic election year for sure. Insults, name calling, and even threats abound. Are you willing to step up and "Meow!", or does the cat have your tongue?





Hebrews 11:1 (NRSV)


