

Selfish Pie For Dessert

I love all holidays. I look forward to them with enthusiasm and excitement. But far and away Thanksgiving is my favorite. There is not the hoopla of exchanging gifts and trying to find just the right thing for somebody. There is no need to go crazy with decorations. There is no need for costumes or fireworks or egg hunts or Hallmark cards. With all due respect and appreciation for those who spend hours preparing and cooking a wonderful meal, Thanksgiving is a day to show up as you are and be, well... thankful.

I spent some time today dwelling on why it is important to express, "Thank you," to someone for something. I know and believe that what you bless and give thanks for expands and you get more of it. And as significant as that may be, is there something other I am missing? And as a side note, it seems a bit disingenuous if your motivation in expressing gratitude is getting more. So what else is there?

After pondering it a bit more, I concluded that it may be proper and right always and everywhere to give thanks to God; God doesn't need it. There are multiple texts in the Hebrew Scriptures that say that God demands not just a "Thank you," but a sacrificial "Thank you." I suspect those passages were inspired by our human tendency to project what somebody else may need or want. What value is there in giving a dollar to somebody who has all the money in the world?

It is very nice to be thanked by someone. Yet, any gift given with joy and love brings about feelings of joy and love for the giver without any expectations in return. To receive thanks is nice, but very incidental really. There is a healthy merit to hearing words of appreciation, but even an ounce of an expectation of a quid pro quo response seems to reduce the richness of the giving at lease a bit.

So doing a bit of a 180, I have concluded that God indeed wants us to be thankful not for any benefit it brings to God, but for our sakes. We try to instill in our children a sense of gratefulness not just to develop in them a proper behavior of politeness, but also to foster in them a heightened sense of consciousness – a deeper sense of knowing that in their humanity is something sacred.

We should be thankful for selfish reasons. We should be grateful in order to have a deeper appreciation of the unlimited abundance that the Universe provides for us. We should give thanks for even the smallest gift that somebody may give to us even if we are suspect of their motivation in the giving. We should write "Thank You" notes first and foremost for our own benefit. Of course all of which I am suggesting assumes that the thanks we express is real and from the heart and not perfunctory. When it is genuine we are being properly and spiritually selfish and fed. When it is not genuine, we are acting contrary to our inner Christ essence.

I have so very much for which to be thankful. For selfish reasons throughout all of November I will work on a greater mindfulness in response to the tons of blessings that I have. I begin with all of you in my church family. I am thankful for each and every one of you, and for the sharing of yourselves as you so generously do. Thanks to you I know greater joy, compassion, wisdom, kindness, love and peace. Thank you for showing me a little clearer Face of God.

Although the commercial world in which we move has catapulted us into the Christmas countdown, I invite us to honor, this year especially, November's sacred holiday of Thanksgiving. No matter what we face as the month progresses, it's important to count our blessings. A basic Unity lesson is that whatever we bless increases. It may sound simple but giving thanks for *what can be* one of the hardest things to do.

As we apply the principles we learn in our practice of Truth, I invite you to contemplate the last two attributes of Unity's basic divine ideas (the Twelve Powers) - *Release* and *Life*.

Mary Kupferle, a classic author of articles published in Unity Magazine, Daily Word, and other publications, tells us in her book, *God Will See You Through*, to "Trust, truly trust, the Spirit within. Your trust frees you from burdens and *releases* you from feelings of

excessive responsibility... Practice trusting God, practice trusting God's presence in you, practice trusting God's presence in others."

She offers the affirmation, "I trust the Spirit within," then suggests that we "let go!"

And as we let God and let go, we open ourselves to the unlimited *life* of God that flows through us, no matter what appears in our outer world...




