### **Ministerial Musings**



My entire life I have pondered over the poetic line: "The stockings were hung by the chimney with care." Why? I understand hanging the stockings. That is how we would get the goodies from Santa. But why with care? Just put the darn stockings up so they are up when Santa comes along.

But today as I reflect upon it, I have a different insight. There is so much hustle and bustle in our lives. We are bombarded with information, advertisements, social media and technology. It is hard to remember days before cell phones and Google and texting. Many times it seems to be overwhelming at least to me.

Have you ever had the experience of going to your computer to look something up or to do something only to become so distracted that you lose track of why you went to the computer? Have you ever walked into a room and then forgot why you went into the room? Please do not tell me I am all alone here.

I think doing something "with care" has become a lost art. Good enough has become good enough. How many things during the day do you do routinely? That is, you do them but without a sense of mindfulness of what you are doing. You do them without making the connection that what you are doing is connected to your very soul.

It is the mindfulness that your being, your soul, is engaged that elevates even the most mundane task to holy and sacred. It is through consciously blessing what you are doing that you become blessed. It is in this state of awareness that what you do becomes energizing rather than fatiguing.

By now perhaps you are thinking, "What's the big deal? You're only hanging the dumb stockings." But that perspective reflects an attitude of separation between what we do and God. The more we go about our business with such an attitude the more we habituate the perspective of distance between our lives and our true Being.

There is nothing trivial about our relationship with Spirit. We are here to participate in creation and make miracles. We are here to birth the Christ within us and not just sometimes, but always. Our rest and peace come to us not in going through motions but rather in putting things into motion. In the motion of the Word taking Flesh, the angels chanted, "Peace to those of good will." Our will is good when we use it willfully.

It is in anticipation of receiving a gift that our mindfulness should be at a high point. It is in this awareness that we hang our stockings with care. There is power and glory in being grateful even before we actually receive a gift. I invite you to make the hanging of your stocking a prayer. Make it a prayer of gratitude for the Christ within that is yet to be made manifest. Give it a try and see if your Christmas becomes even more meaningful.

At our latest <u>Board</u> Meeting we discussed the <u>fundraiser</u> and how we might energize support to cover expenses exceeding income in 2024. We evaluated the <u>Annual Meeting</u> for changes to make it better. <u>Fun Fall Outing</u> was declared a success, another in the line of Activities showing the most interest which we were able to provide members with the help of tireless volunteers and their endearing spirit. 2025 Budget was reviewed and approved with some clarification and minor adjustment. Ongoing insurance cost increase is being shopped for relief. Finalized discussions on adjacent property.

We also made plans for the January 11 Board Meeting/Retreat. One of the items to be worked on at the retreat is a plan and committee to prepare for welcoming potential new members from a new 880 household development being built in Batavia: all part of visualizing our future at Unity of Fox Valley.

### **Prayer Chaplain Ministry**

Starting with the August newsletter I chose specific themes to carry us through the months ahead. I started in August with *faith*. September's topic was *hope*, leading to *action* in October. Last month's touched on Unity's eleventh and twelfth powers (*release & life*), culminating with *trust*. We're now in December, moving into the winter holiday season of Christmas, Kwanza and Chanukah, to name a few of the special days that are celebrated.



And, despite the fact that what I had had faith in, had hoped for, and trusted would be, did not turn out as I had envisioned, in my heart of hearts, as a Truth student, during this Christmas season I am setting my intention to focus on *love* and *joy*!

(In light of the month we've just experienced, if you're not ready to go there, it's ok. {This writer continues to have her ups and downs, since you know when...} But, if you don't choose to read the rest of this piece, please do read the essay on Grief by Maria Cosentino, LUT, Spiritual Education Director, and PC Emerita.)

There's another of the Twelve Powers that I invite you to tap into in the coming days, months, and years - the power of Strength. In a Unity book, *PowerUP*, the Reverends Paul Hasselbeck, D.D.S. and Cher Hilton, Ph.D. describe strength as the "ability to endure, stay the course, last, be persistent, persevere, and be stable." We can use this power of strength to adopt **Amor Fati**, "love of (one's) fate," an ancient concept Deb McQuaid, LUT and Prayer Chaplain Emerita, shared with us in her talk on Sunday, November 17th. Quoting Google, "Some say that this mindset can help ... put one's energy and emotion where they'll have the most impact."

No matter what your mindset is at this moment, I suggest you use *Prayer and Meditation* to help you touch into your *strength* as you experience a meaningful Christmas season. These tools may not seem to change the world *outside* you, but they can, and will, change the world *within* you...


