## **Ministerial Musings**



Here we are. Christmas pretty much is in the rearview mirror. And not to bring anybody down, but the harsh reality is that winter only officially began just ten days ago. We have another three months of dressing in layers, wearing mittens, winter coats, winter hats and the dreadful possibility of boots. I am personally grateful for my baby blue blanket.

Today I regard Jack and Suzy and Frosty as loving prophets who taught me how to celebrate the zest of life and winter. # Youth Education for a Younger Crowd

As we box away the festive ornaments and bid farewell to the holiday season, our youth and their teachers will embrace the New Year with a celebration and renewal through our *Burning Bowl* and *White Stone Ceremony*. This meaningful, yearly tradition will encourage us to release what no longer serves us to make room for a fresh start filled with positive intentions for the new year. We will begin our *Burning Bowl Ceremony* downstairs with a guided meditation as an opportunity to reflect on both the tangible and intangible aspects of our lives. We will gently focus on our challenges such as fears, worries, or habits that no longer serve our overall well-being.

After the meditation, we will write these thoughts down on flash paper as a symbolic way of letting them go. With our papers in hand, we will join the congregation upstairs to release our papers into the Burning Bowl in a calm and safe manner.

Once this part of the ceremony concludes, we will return downstairs for our *White Stone Ceremony*. This is a time when we will engage in another reflective meditation, followed by inscribing words or ideas on white stones that represent the positive intentions we hope to embrace in 2025 and beyond. This inspiring ritual will set a positive and meaningful tone for the year ahead.

Also, for this month of January, the youth will focus on exploring the concept of the Power of Faith. Dark Blue is the color that represents this power, and it is associated with the disciple Peter. We will encourage the youth to understand how faith is our highest affirming faculty, empowering us to align our thoughts, emotions, words, and actions in agreement with the Divine ideas of God. To deepen this understanding, we will delve into the Bible stories of David and Goliath and Jesus Calms the Storm, as examples to teach the kids that faith in God can help them overcome any obstacles, no matter how impossible they seem.




