## **Ministerial Musings**



There are so many holidays celebrated in June that it is difficult to pick one. The one that really caught my eye was <u>Bunker Hill Day</u>. Many times, in my life I have heard the expression, "Bunker Hill," but I never knew the full story.

It is a holiday that is celebrated principally in Massachusetts. The battle took place in 1775 during the revolutionary war. Colonial military captured Boston and learned that the British planned to take over Bunker Hill strategically located on the Charleston Peninsula. American troops built a small fort and fortified the areas around the peninsula.

On June 17, the British learned that American troops had taken over the hill and decided to attack that day. The British army unit had over 2200 soldiers and outnumbered American troops by over two to one. Colonial troops were ordered not to fire until the British soldiers were only just a few yards away. It was a successful strategy that forced the British troops to retreat.

A second attack was launched and again the British troops were unsuccessful. However, on the third attempt the Americans were low on ammunition and were outnumbered, and they were routed in hand-to-hand combat. The Americans were forced to retreat to Cambridge, and the British took the hill.

After reading the historical account, I thought it was weird that the people of Massachusetts every year celebrated what ultimately was a losing endeavor. After giving it some thought, I concluded that while colonists indeed had lost the battle, the battle helped pave the way to winning the war. By showing up as they did, colonial soldiers put a large dent in the British army and created a consciousness of, "Hey, we can win this thing." In so doing, surely the British army must have come to realize the resilience and determination of the colonial army, and a knowing that winning the war was not a given.

There is a Spiritual aspect to this story. God never promised that things we are called to do would be easy. Surely, it was not easy for Noah to build an ark especially since it was likely that he did not have a clue what a cubit was. Plus, how long must he have had to search to find a male and female mosquito?



Ultimately, resilience and resolution come to us through the realization of who and what we are coupled with an understanding and commitment to our purpose. This is not an easy place to get to both in our minds and hearts, particularly when the circumstances and adversaries try to convince us we have no chance. The lesson for us is that outcomes and consequences are secondary to consciousness and Spiritual growth.

These days we all face challenging times. Eventually they all become personal, and the battles that ensue always are between our fears and our very being, aka our Spiritual integrity. Sometimes discretion may be the better part of valor and there is wisdom in knowing when to pick your battles. That all is well and good providing they do not become convenient strategies that choke off living and loving.

Surely the colonists who fought at Bunker Hill did not think that battle alone would determine the outcome of the war. But they must have understood that if they did not fight the battle, their purpose and the war already were lost. Sometimes you just have to "Bunker" down.


