As we have stepped into 2023, I'd like to reflect on what a fabulous year 2022 had been in Youth Ed! The youth had delved into a vast array of spiritual explorations through their Power Boards, Bible stories, crafts, and, most notably, through their presentations. Two of our youth, Aimee and Lilah, each had shared an inspirational talk one Sunday on "What Unity Means to Me", and the entire Youth Ed had presented the Parable of the Lamp for their Fall Intergenerational Service and their infamous, heartwarming Christmas Pageant to close out the year. We are so truly blessed and grateful to all our youth and their parents/teachers that lovingly and enthusiastically participated in all of these memorable spiritual events.

We will start our 2023 classes on **Sunday**, **January 8**, with the youth of all age groups and their teachers/parents participating in our traditional **Burning Bowl/White Stone Ceremony**. We will begin downstairs with a meditation, reflecting on intangible and tangible things, such as fears/worries and staying up too late/eating too much candy, respectively, that we will conclude are no longer necessary in our lives. For the remainder of January, the youth will be exploring the **Power of Faith**. The color for this **Power is Dark Blue** and the **Disciple is Peter**. To enhance our understanding of this Power with respect to our spiritual beliefs, we will be exploring several Miracles of Jesus, such as his walking on water and his healing of the blind man. This power of Faith is the perfect power to kick-start the other eleven Powers for the remaining eleven months of the year!

In closing, I wish to express how deeply appreciative I am to all of you for your loving support and encouragement for the youth in our program.

"As I meditate on the mystery of love and life, I receive the treasure of spiritual understanding."


As 2023 begins, I invite you to "Affirm Understanding" and open your divine self to the unlimited possibilities that lie ahead this new year.


