## Ministerial Musings



Well, it is October, and we cannot get by without thinking about witches, at least I can't. When most people hear the word 'witch', their imagination takes them sprinting toward crooked noses, bubbling cauldrons, and cackles that sound suspiciously like your Aunt Matilda after her third glass of merlot. But for the record: not all witches do the "boil, boil, toil and trouble" thing. In fact, a growing number of people proudly embrace witchcraft not as something dark or sinister, but as something nourishing, spiritual and I dare say... delightful.

First, let's tackle the obvious: good witches exist, and they don't spend their evenings plotting against Disney princesses. They are more likely to be found meditating under a full moon, making herbal tea blends, or softly whispering encouraging words to their houseplants. They are not in it to conquer the world - they are in it for healing, balance, and connection with the universe (plus, let's be real, crystal collections are way prettier than death rays).

Witchcraft, at its core, is about relationships. They embody the idea that magic or miracles do not have to be scary. It can be healing, joyful and even funny.

So, the next time someone mentions witches, don't picture a bad person in a pointy hat. Picture someone stirring a prayer into their tea, talking kindly to the moon, and maybe, just maybe, sending you a little loving energy when you need it the most. After all, there's something pretty world could use a little more magic.

## Notes from the Board

At our September Board meeting after reviewing and approving August minutes and Treasurer's Report, we got down to the business of expenses over income. Going forward each fundraiser will have a separate budget line. As happens every year unexpected maintenance comes up. This year it is the sprinklers and electrical update will follow. With this in mind, along with income not increasing with inflation which increases expenses we are going to have another Drive Thru BBQ and Fall Fundraiser: Invest in our Future.

Every member of the Board will speak to the congregation about Investing in Unity of Fox Valley as we start the "Invest In Our Future" Fall fundraiser. We also need a few more volunteers to have enough people to handle the Drive Thru BBQ. October 14th, 4-6pm: WHO IS AVAILABLE? Success will depend on Unity of Fox Valley buying dinners

and leaving the cooking to others...or give Gift Certificates for meals...or sell a choice of 2 pork chops, 2 pcs of chicken or one of each including baked beans, coleslaw, applesauce and a roll \$20! We are getting 8 signs made which will have changeable dates to reuse for future events.

Fundraisers like this decrease the amount needed for the Fall Fundraiser. We are creating an additional form to be used for money processing of any significant amount, for example Drive Thru BBQ, Garage Sale, Essential Oils, Fall Fundraiser. Amounts will be submitted with two signatures, similar to the way weekly collection is handled but include income and expense by each event; the treasurer and event coordinator will be able to advise the Board to improve decision making.

Our CPR class had 22 in attendance. Thank you to those who joined us. We are safer here as well as where those trained go out into the world. The Cougar's game was a fun get together and well attended. Ticket sales for the Abbey Farms outing is about to begin to repeat an outing enjoyed very much last year. The youth can enjoy any activity over and over and over...

The next Board meeting is October 13th. The Board Retreat will be January 10th with Ellen Schnur providing us more direction at Nazareth Spirituality Center in Batavia. We followed Ellen's advice this year and got to know each other better engaging in a question each month we tell each other about ourselves. Passing along should anyone want to start a conversation to know someone better: "If you could change anything about the way you were raised what would it be." In case you haven't gotten to know our Board members well, they are a kind, thoughtful, often funny, bright, empathetic, caring, and financially responsible group with uniquely wonderful individuals!






